Job Description:

The Teachers Retirement System of the City of New York (TRS) is a public pension fund that provides New York City educators with retirement, disability, and death benefits. TRS is one of the largest pension plan sponsors in the United States, with more than \$10 billion in assets and over 1 million members, retirees, and beneficiaries.

TRS Office of Operation is looking for a Business Analyst who will play a critical role in managing change and supporting business transformation in line with the organization's future state operational goals. The successful candidate will elaborate on and define target state business processes, resource requirements, exception handling processes and operating procedures. s/he will coordinate closely with key stakeholders to ensure the organization is operationally ready for implementation of new processes, roles and technology.

Responsibilities:

Essential duties and responsibilities

- Utilize Business Process Modeling (BPM) tools and techniques to prepare end-to-end process models related to the delivery of TRS products and services. Perform gap analysis between the current and future state and identify opportunities for improvement.
- Write clear and well-structured business requirements, via user stories and/or requirements documents, and serve as a key facilitator between the solution team and the organization.
- Support the Organizational Change Management (OCM) effort by collaborating with Technical Writers, Operational Help Desk (OHD) representatives and trainers to ensure accuracy and consistency of information disseminated to end users.
- Perform impact analyses on the current organization by utilizing TRS business architecture and target operating models (including products and services, enabling business processes, supporting IT services, and responsible roles/organizations).
- Assist with the development of standard operating procedures (SOPs) and work instructions to support implementation of the target operating models.
- Support operational analysis of production issues and identify potential service level requirements.
- Collaborate with Process Owners and other key stakeholders to define business services, associated Service Level Agreements (SLAs) and Operational Level Agreements (OLAs) and ensure agreement on Service Level Targets (SLTs).
- Identify exception process activities for resolution of exceptions in support of exception procedures.
- Perform volumetric analysis of key organizational processes to identify resource requirements for interim and target state processes.
