| 20 | MS. DeLEO: Required Minimum Distributions ("RMD") were |
| 21 | completed for 2013 with distributions being made to approximately |
| 22 | 18, 300 TDA members with Deferral Status and TDA Beneficiary |
| 23 | Accounts. Roughly 11,500 of these distributions were made in the |
| 24 | month of December. 116 first-time RMD recipients that reached |

70% in 2013, have deferred their distribution to between January $1^{\rm st}$

Preparations are underway to send out the $4^{\rm th}$ Quarter 2013 statements. The Quarterly Account Statement for members currently in-service or on leave is expected to begin mailing the week of February $2^{\rm nd}$ to an estimated population of approximately 113,000 members with an additional 6,000 members receiving electronic statements through our website.

Online posting of the TDA Quarterly Statement for Participants with TDA Deferral Status is expected to begin concurrent with statements being printed. The estimated population is 45,000, approximately 43,000 will be printed and mailed, and an additional 1,300 members have elected to view their statements online only.

Mailing of the TDA Quarterly Statement for Beneficiary Participants, to an estimated population of 500 members, is expected to occur on January $27^{\rm th}$.

TRS has undertaken an initiative to make significant improvements and provide greater flexibility for members that participate in our TDA program. Members taking withdrawals from their TDA accounts will now receive their funds more quickly. Most requests will be processed in less than 45 days. For withdrawals taken from money invested in the Fixed Return Fund only, payments can normally be made within 15 days. (Previously, it took 60-90 days for members to receive their withdrawals.) Additionally, we anticipate that members will be able to make TDA withdrawal

- 2 requests online by accessing the secure section of our website 3 starting mid-February.

TDA participants now have the option to effect investment election changes within one month. Previously, conversions of the TDA funds had to be spread out over 3, 6, 9, or 12 months.

The one month option is available for changes that take effect on or after April 1, 2014.
