MS. REILLY: On March 26th, we implemented a new member inquiry tracking system in our Call Center and Walk-In Center. The software package is an "off-the-shelf" package, which was configured to support our Member Services Unit by automating the tracking of all member inquires.

On April 2nd, TRS implemented changes to our Tax-Deferred Annuity (TDA) loan program in order to support the Board Resolution that passed on February 25th requiring that the interest rate for a TDA participant's loan be the same as the interest rate in effect for that participant's Fixed Return Fund at the time the loan was issued. The Board Resolution goes into effect with loans issued by TRS on or after April 16th.

Since our last Board Meeting, the Member Education /
Staff Development Unit conducted seven (7) sessions
including: "Your TRS Benefits and Services" and
"Introduction to the TDA Program" on "Getting Ready for
Retirement" for Tier I, Tier II and Tier IV members.
