24	MR. McTIGUE: Our first item for
25	business today is an update on TRS operations,

2	and I will turn it over, if it pleases the
3	Board, to Ival Grant-Williams to provide that
4	update.
5	MS. GRANT-WILLIAMS: Good afternoon,
6	everybody. So there is three updates today
7	regarding operations. The first one is new
8	enrollments. So far this school year,
9	approximately 4,000 new members have been
10	enrolled with TRS, based on the data received
11	from the Department of Education, the City
12	University of New York, and charter schools.
13	New members receive a welcome letter from TRS
14	when they are enrolled.
15	The second update is in regards to the
16	annual benefits statement. The 2022 annual
17	benefits statements have been completed for
18	approximately 127,700 members in active
19	service or on leave. Members will be informed
20	later this month by e-mail when their
21	statements are available for reviewing in the
22	secure section of the website.
23	The last update is in regards to member
24	expiration. TRS will be mailing letters this
25	month to about 1,300 members who have been

2	inactive for seven consecutive school years
3	advising them that their membership has
4	expired. Those are all the updates regarding
5	operations.
6	MR. BROWN: Can you possibly send that
7	to us electronically?
8	MS. GRANT-WILLIAMS: Absolutely.
9	MS. PENNY: So the end of the month
10	people will get the e-mail about the ABS. Do
11	you think by November is it safe to say
12	sometime in November they will receive
13	their
14	MS. GRANT-WILLIAMS: Yes. Yes.
15	MS. PENNY: Perfect. Thank you.
16	MR. McTIGUE: Anything further? If not,
17	we will move on to the update from Mr.
18	Tyszkiewicz from the Actuary's Office.

20	regarding the GASB reports. The pension and
21	the OPEB GASB reports have been provided to
22	the Comptroller. Copies have been provided to
23	the Board. They are also available on the
24	Office of the Actuary's website in the reports
25	page.

2	One thing interesting to note in the
3	OPEB valuation the GASB $74/75$, you will see a
4	big drop in OPEB liabilities. That's due to
5	an increase in the discount rate for OPEB.
6	The discount rate is not set by the Actuary.
7	It's determined by GASB, and based on the
8	rules in GASB, it's primarily driven, in the
9	case of the city, based on the municipal bond
10	20 year index rates which increased from 2.19
11	percent in the last valuation to 4.09 percent
12	So almost a doubling of the discount rate
13	created this 20 percent reduction in OPEB
14	liabilities. Those are all my updates.
15	MS. PENNY: Thank you.
16	MR. McTIGUE: If nothing further, we
17	will move to the executive director's report.
18	Two items on that report today. Next meeting
19	It's been suggested that the next regular
20	meeting of the Teachers' Retirement Board be
21	held on the third Thursday of the month,
22	November 17, 2022. So mark your calendars.
23	That would be appreciated.
