Annette Hanrahan is now our Director of Information Technology. Bob, who was previously our Director of Information Technology has now been elevated to our Chief Information Officer. Andrew Bradford is now our Chief Risk Officer. Both Annette and Andrew have been with us many years and have a great, proven track record and we look forward to working with them. Congratulations.

The next item on the Agenda is Updates on TRS Operations.

MS. REILLY: The Annual Benefits Statements ("ABS") began mailing on November 15<sup>th</sup>. We will be mailing approximately 113,000 statements to our members. We anticipate that the mailing should be completed by the end of November. Our Quarterly Account Statements ("QAS") for the third quarter started mailing on November 17<sup>th</sup>. We will be mailing over 108,000 statements and we expect that mailing to also be completed by the end of November. We also completed the mailing of our quarterly Tax-Deferred Annuity ("TDA") Statements for 39,000 members with TDA deferral status. We completed that on November 15<sup>th</sup>. In addition, we also mailed 461 TDA Beneficiary Statements on November 5<sup>th</sup>. TRS began its TDA

our TDA program as a supplemental retirement plan. Posters were sent to schools with the message, "Your bridge to a Secure Retirement." We also made updates to our website promoting the TDA program and have included an article in the TRS newsletter. On Saturday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, the TRS Member Services Team and Stakeholder Relations Unit participated in the 46<sup>th</sup> CSA Leadership Conference. In preparation for this member outreach initiative, 400 TRS informational kits containing various brochures, TDA flyers, and member education program registration forms were assembled. Our Member Education Department also hosted a presentation at the conference entitled "TRS Benefits Working For You." Attendance was standing-room only for the presentation and we received good feedback regarding the presentation from members who attended.

MR. SERRANO: Thank you. The next item is just a reminder that you have an updated Calendar of Events and that you will be receiving them every two (2) months now. The next item on the Agenda is the Executive Director's Report. The first item there is the Next Meeting. It has been suggested that the next regular meeting of the Teachers' Retirement Board be held on the third Thursday of the month, December 16, 2010. The next item is the laid-over resolution concerning electing a chairperson.

MR. SERRANO: The next item is just a Notification. Last month, we passed a resolution that made reference to a prior resolution. The date indicated in the prior resolution was incorrect. The date initially mentioned was October 18, 2007 but the correct date should be October 25, 2007. This notification is just to correct the record. It does not need to be voted upon again.

The next item is a Budget Modification to Support Analysis to Improve TDA and Variable Services. I would like to give you all a little bit of background on that. As I have mentioned previously, TRS is exploring the introduction of enhanced services for its Variable and TDA participants. This resolution is requesting to engage the resources necessary to research these services and the technical support necessary.

A significant amount of effort and cost will go towards an analysis of the alternative ways to modernize our computer system to support these new business requirements, and to work with outside resources to develop a detailed implementation plan, including true time and cost estimates for each alternative.

Before I identify some of the features we are exploring, please note that some of them, such as the Roth TDA, could only be implemented if later directed by the Board and/or enabling legislation is passed. The type of features we are looking at

are: Daily Fund Valuations (currently, we only value the funds monthly and publish a unit value 15 days into the following month); Daily Account Valuation (currently, accounts are only updated on a monthly basis); On-line Real-time Account Information through the TRS Web-site (currently, there is a 3 to 7 week lag between posting updated account balances and it is an area of dissatisfaction for the members); Immediate, Endof-Day Fund Conversions (currently, member can only request fund conversions quarterly and it takes 3 to 12 months to complete the conversion); Roth TDAs (which are permitted by recently federal legislation); More Fund Choices and the ability to establish those new funds more quickly (we currently have 6 investment options); On-line User Friendly Transaction Requests with Rapid Turn-around Times through the TRS Web-site (based on surveys we have heard from our members that they are interested in having more of these types of features on-line); Account Balancing / Periodic Re-balancing (members who are interested in maintaining a particular mix in their funds have to monitor themselves and then initiate fund conversions and usually by the time the 3 to 12 months are completed to process the fund conversion, the balances are not there anymore); We are looking at introducing an automatic rebalancing feature and automated processing of TDA contributions from CUNY and Charter Schools. Currently, this is a very manual process and it

really needs to be improved. There are various other

upgrades that we are looking at, but those are a few of the

highlights.

There are three (3) broad types of consulting costs that will be incurred: i) Consultants needed to backfill for current TRS staff, so that we can free them up to participate in the project without hurting the ongoing operation of our existing systems. ii) Consultants needed to assist in the comparative analysis project so that we can evaluate what is the best way to upgrade our computer system to support the new business rules. iii) Consultants to provide specialized services, including: quality assurance, business rule extraction and validation, change management, project time and cost estimation, and business analysis. As indicated in the resolution, if approved, the Corpus funding for this work will come 100% from the Variable and TDA fund fees.

Before I go back to the resolution, are there any questions or comments? Hearing none, I will go back to the resolution and read the Resolved.

Resolved, that the agency budget for Fiscal Year 2011 be increased in the amount of \$1,850,000.00, to be taken from TDA and Variable Program funds, to provide for this enhancement of the TDA assessment and analysis project.
